We provide services with a passion and focus on self-care, respect, compassion and collaboration to be able to respond to the needs of our community. We are committed to upholding our values of diversity, equity and inclusion on a governing board. We welcome applications from all qualified individuals including but not limited to Indigenous peoples and minority populations, persons of any sexual or gender orientation, individuals living with disabilities or any other individual that wants to uphold our views and has a passion to make a difference in the lives of individuals experiencing or who have experienced gender based violence.

- Contribute to effective board governance decision making and provide thoughtful comments and input as needed
- Run overall governance of Wilma's by establishing and monitoring policies and programs and supporting development and effectiveness of the Board
- Establish strategic purpose and direction of Wilma's by participating in regular strategic planning and monitoring performance towards the plans results
- · Represent Wilma's and its programs and services to stakeholders, including community funders and clients
- Ensure the financial health of Wilma's by complying with fiscal policies and procedures and through ongoing analysis of financial reports
- Hire the Executive Director while ensuring that they have the necessary leadership abilities, skills, experience, education and personality to lead Wilma's into its full potential and monitoring the ED's performance towards responsibilities and yearly objectives
